



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


MUNSHI MEMORIAL DAY


MANTHAN: A CELEBRATION OF TALENT AND TRADITION

Asheervachanam – A Sacred Beginning to a New Chapter





Makes space for something new.







Ingredients:


Grated paneer, bread slices, butter, chopped onion, capsicum, salt, and a pinch of pepper.
